Physicians, nurse practitioners and physicians assistants who wish to gain a greater understanding of treatment options available for stroke patients.

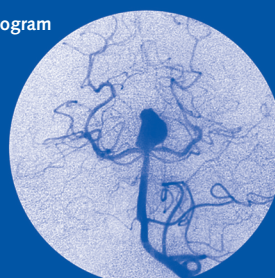
Course Fee

Conference fee of \$40.00 per person includes lunch, refreshments, social hour, course materials and CME credit.

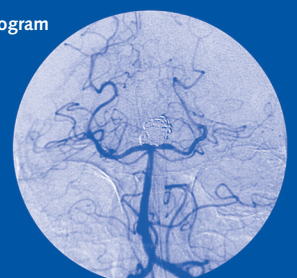

Pre



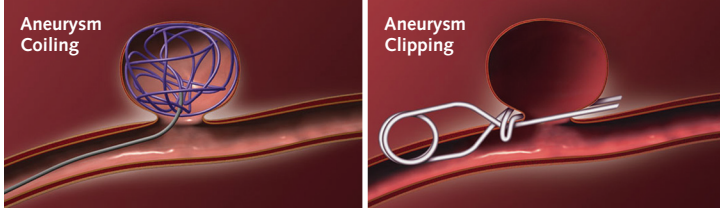
Angiogram

Theda Clark Stroke Center – Uniquely qualified to care for all stroke patients.

Stroke is the 3rd leading cause of death and the number one cause of disability in the United States.

Theda Clark Medical Center and Appleton Medical Center have developed a comprehensive system for rapid diagnosis and treatment of stroke patients admitted to the emergency department. This includes always being equipped to provide brain imaging scans, having neurologists available to conduct patient evaluations, and using clot-busting medications or mechanical devices when appropriate.



The Theda Clark Stroke Center is certified as a Primary Stroke Center by The Joint Commission. This designation means a hospital meets specific criteria for managing and treating stroke, including 24-hour acute stroke teams made up of neurologists, neuro-interventionalists, neurohospitalists and specially trained nurses, an integrated emergency response system, a dedicated stroke unit, neuro-services including imaging and state-of-the-art intervention, written care protocols, rehabilitation (speech, physical and occupational therapy), and ongoing quality improvement and education programs.

In addition, both Theda Clark Medical Center and Appleton Medical Center recently received the Gold Performance Achievement Award from the American Stroke Association's Get With The GuidelinesSM – Stroke program. Hospitals that receive the GWTC-Stroke Gold Performance Achievement Award have adhered to the GWTC – Stroke key measures for 24 or more consecutive months at least 85 percent of the time. These include aggressive use of medications like tPA, antithrombotics, anticoagulation therapy, DVT prophylaxis, cholesterol-reducing drugs, and smoking cessation.

ThedaCare is the only system in the state, including academic centers, to receive this honor for both of its hospitals.

Continuing Medical Education (CME)

ThedaCare hospitals are accredited by the Wisconsin Medical Society to provide continuing medical education for physicians. ThedaCare has applied for 4 CMEs for this education activity.

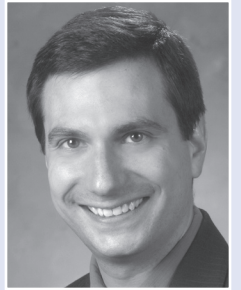
